#### **CLUES**

Make the clues at about a Monday to Wednesday New York Times difficulty level.

#### **SUBMISSION**

Only email submissions will be considered. Please send your puzzle to David Steinberg at ocregister crosswords@gmail.com as a Crossword Compiler file.

#### **PAYMENT**

A payment of \$50 will be made upon publication.
