Abstract

We have systematically explored a new class of organolanthanides. These include complexes of lanthanides (II, III), as well as yttrium (III), containing the dianions of tetraphenylethylene and benzylidene fluorene. Syntheses, spectroscopic, and structural studies of these and related species will be discussed in detail.
